# Tesco Widnes Bags of Help Scheme

We are trying to raise funds to purchase new sports equipment for school and Tesco in Widnes have included us in their Bags of Help Scheme.

Bags of Help is Tesco's exciting local community grant scheme where the money raised from the 5p bag charge is being used to fund thousands of local projects.

Projects that bring benefit to their community will get the green light - these range from improving community buildings and outdoor spaces to buying new equipment and hosting community events.

Three community projects in each local area will be voted on by customers. Following the vote, the project that received the most votes in its area will receive a grant of up to £4,000, second place receiving up to £2,000 and third place up to £1,000.

Customers are given a token when they buy their shopping that they can use to make their choice using the voting units in most stores. You will receive one token per transaction and it is not necessary to purchase a carrier bag in order to receive a token.

Voting starts week ending 7<sup>th</sup> May until Friday 30<sup>th</sup> June.
