Snack

We are receiving a lot of queries over snack, so I would like to clarify how snack works.

Snack is 30p per day, or £1.50 per week for which your child will receive a slice of toast and a glass of milk.

Several parents are choosing to pay half termly. When we return after half term, there are seven weeks until we break up for Christmas. If you would like to pay for the whole half term, it will be £10.50.

I appreciate that this may not be possible for some of you, so therefore can I suggest you pay weekly.

Please put the exact money in an envelope with your child's name and class and ask your child to pass this to their teacher. Each teacher keeps a record of snack money received which is passed to the Toast Monitor each day.



The teacher is unable to give you change which is why I am asking for the exact money.

If your child does not pay for snack they will not receive any that day.

If you would like to provide your child with their own snack, please ensure it is fruit only. It is impossible to monitor cereal bars as many contain a lot of sugar.

I am very grateful to all parents who already follow this process.
