Monday 6th November – Friday 10th November

Next week we will be taking part in Science Week which is being delivered by Daresbury Laboratories. There are lots of exciting activities planned throughout the week for the whole school.



On Monday there will be a Planetarium in the School Hall. Reception through to Year 4 will be visiting the Planetarium throughout the day and from 3.00pm until 3.30pm, **Years 5 and 6 ONLY can visit the Planetarium with their parents.** Younger siblings who have already visited the Planetarium during the day cannot visit at this time.

Please come to the main entrance with your child if you wish to attend.

The Planetarium is set up within a huge inflatable dome. It is a darkened environment in which there may be rapid changes of light. ***If your child might be affected by this, please let the office know before Monday afternoon.***

On Tuesday, Liverpool John Moore's University will be delivering an assembly on Space to KS2 and doing a workshop with Year 5.
