Please find below some reminders about events and activities in school.

School Day

School starts at 9.00am and finishes at 3.00pm each day. The doors are open from 8.50am. Please ensure your child comes in through the rear door and not the front door. If your child arrives after 9.00am, they will need to come in the front door where they will be marked down as late.

Breakfast Club starts at 8.30am and is completely free to all the children. There is toast, cereal, milk and tea available. There is no need to book a place for your child. A register is taken upon their arrival.

Celebration Assembly and Star of the Week

Thank you to everyone who came to our first Celebration Assembly of this academic year.

All parents are invited to our Celebration Assembly every Friday at 9.15am. It is our time to celebrate our children's achievements in and outside of school. We also announce each class 'Star of the Week' and will invite those parents to come and watch their child receive their award.

Mrs Towers will notify you by email on the Thursday if your child is Star of the Week, therefore, please can you ensure the office has your up to date email address. This will allow you to make arrangements if you would like to attend the assembly on Friday morning.

School Menu

Please remember to go through the school menu with your child before they come to school and help them make their choice. After October half term, we will be issuing a new menu.

Snack Money

Snack money is 30p per day or £1.50 per week. Please send the money in with your child, who will give this to their class teacher. Each class teacher records the snack money on their own snack register. Please do not send money into the office unless you are paying for the half term. The office cannot guarantee that they will be able to pass the message to your child's class teacher before snack time.

As we provide a free breakfast club to all children, only children who pay for snack will receive snack at breaktime.

Free School Meals

Parents can now apply for free school meals online. If you believe that your child may be eligible to receive free school meals, please can you make an application using the following link -

If you have more than one child in the school, you must make an application for each child.

School will then be notified if your application has been successful.

For each child that is eligible to receive Free School Meals, the school receives money which can be used to purchase resources and equipment for school. Therefore, it is vitally important that you check if you are eligible as this money supports our school budget and enables us to offer a more varied curriculum to our children.
