

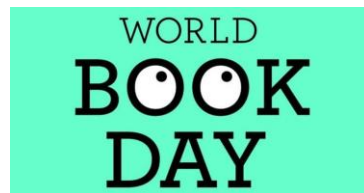

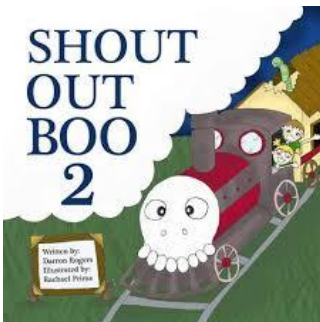
Your child can bring in their favourite book, if they have one.

Starlight Clothing Collection

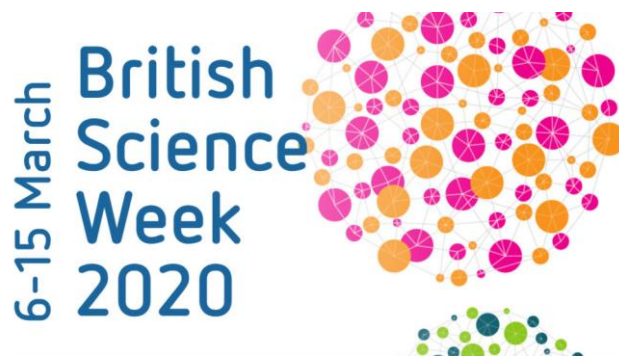
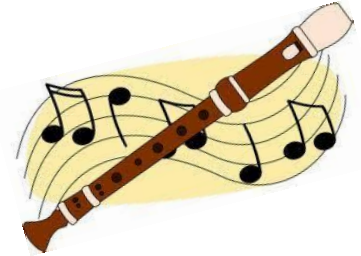
