

Sports Premium



What is Sports Premium?

Sports Premium is additional government funding allocated by the LA to schools with eligible pupils meeting the required criteria. This funding is then ring-fenced by each school to be spent on sport and health improvement activities.

Allocations for the academic year 2015 to 2016 are calculated using the number of pupils in years 1 to 6, as recorded in the January 2015 census, as follows:

- schools with 17 or more pupils receive £8,000 plus £5 per pupil
- schools with 16 or fewer pupils receive £500 per pupil

As a school we have the freedom to decide how to this money is best spent in order to meets the needs of the children in our school.

At Windmill Hill, we have always had excellent sports provision and this has enabled us to enhance it further.

In 2014/15 our funding was £8,510 and this money was spent on:

- Football coaching with experienced professional
- Games coaching with experienced professional
- Rugby coaching with Widnes Vikings
- After school Rugby club run by Widnes Vikings
- After school football club
- After school and in school coaching from LA
- Transport to inter-schools athletics, football and rugby fixtures
- Transport to swimming/ cost of swimming coach
- Outdoor and adventurous activities (including forest school equipment).

In 2015/16 our funding was £8,581 and this money was spent on:

- Football coaching with experienced professional
- Games coaching with experienced professional
- Rugby coaching with Widnes Vikings
- After school Rugby club run by Widnes Vikings
- After school football club
- After school and in school coaching from LA
- Transport to inter-schools athletics, football and rugby fixtures
- Transport to swimming/ cost of swimming coach
- Outdoor and adventurous activities (including forest school equipment and residential visit).
